3. Purposes and legal bases of processing

We process personal data of our business partners for the following purposes:

- for the preparation, implementation and processing of contractual relationships (e.g. preparation of offers, order processing, invoicing)
- for communication in the context of the business relationship
- To comply with legal obligations (e.g. commercial and tax regulations)
- to safeguard legitimate interests, e.g. to maintain business contacts or to enforce legal claims

The legal bases are:

- Art. 6 (1) (b) GDPR (contract and pre-contractual measures)
- Art. 6 (1) (c) GDPR (legal obligation)
- Art. 6 (1) (f) GDPR (legitimate interest)

4. Categories of data processed

In particular, the following are processed:

- Contact details (name, business phone number, email address, position in the company)
- Communication data
- Contract data (e.g. orders, invoices, delivery dates)
- Payment and billing information
- Company affiliation data

5. Recipients of the data

Personal data may be processed internally by the relevant departments. External recipients can be:

- Service providers in the context of order processing (e.g. IT service providers)
- Authorities and public bodies in the event of legal obligations
- Banks, Tax Advisors and Lawyers
- Logistics or shipping service providers

A transfer will only take place if this is necessary for the fulfilment of the contract, for the protection of our interests or due to legal obligations.

6. Data transfer to third countries

A transfer to countries outside the EU/EEA will only take place if this is necessary for the performance of the contract, is required by law or you have given your consent. In these cases, we ensure that an adequate level of data protection is guaranteed.

7. Storage period

Personal data will be stored for the duration of the business relationship and beyond in accordance with the statutory retention periods (e.g. § 257 HGB, § 147 AO – up to 10 years).

8. Rights of data subjects

You have the right to:

- to information pursuant to Art. 15 GDPR
- to rectification of incorrect data (Art. 16 GDPR)
- to deletion ("right to be forgotten", Art. 17 GDPR), provided that there are no statutory retention obligations to the contrary
- to restriction of processing (Art. 18 GDPR)
- to object to processing (Art. 21 GDPR), insofar as it is based on legitimate interests
- to data portability (Art. 20 GDPR)
